# Hon'ble Chief Minister Inspected TBM Adyar Breakthrough



On February 13, 2025, **Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu,Thiru. M.K. Stalin** inspected the breakthrough of TBM Adyar near Adyar Junction Metro Station, a key milestone in Corridor 3 of Chennai Metro's Phase 2 project.

The tunneling work, which began in June 2023 from Greenways Road Metro Station, covered a distance of 1.218 km, overcoming complex challenges such as varying soil conditions, hard rock formations, high groundwater levels, and urban constraints. The TBM bored beneath the Adyar River at a depth of approximately 40 to 50 feet over a 300-meter stretch.




### **Meeting conducted on Madurai Metro Rail Project**
